Project Reef Balls: Curaçao Children Paint to Protect the Reefs with Artist Rogest

Seven local Curaçao kids teamed up with visiting artist Rogest and Ocean Encounters to create a masterpiece of awareness. The aim was simple: How can the kids of today protect the reefs for tomorrow? With the power of paint, the kids set out to create a work of art. Now complete, this painting has been turned into a limited-edition print by the Rogest Studio. The prints will be sold and distributed throughout the worldwide dive community. The proceeds will be used to purchase and install new reef balls in Curaçao.



A reef ball is a round concrete construction that is installed on sandy bottoms for coral polyps to attach and grow. It also has several holes that allow small fish and other life to hide and develop.

The finished work of art is now hanging at the Ocean Encounters shop for all to enjoy.
