Reef help deployed

Artificial reef builders, The Reef Ball Development Group, will place several concrete reef balls on a site in the Lake Worth lagoon Friday.



The company deployed a number of the structures at the same place last year. They are designed to give fish and other marine animals shelter.

The project is part of an attempt to market the reef balls around the nation. They are different from other reefs because they may be floated with a reusable air bladder, then sunk where planned. Multiple reef balls are usually sunk together in formation.

The deployment will occur at 3:30 p.m. Friday south of Peanut Island.
