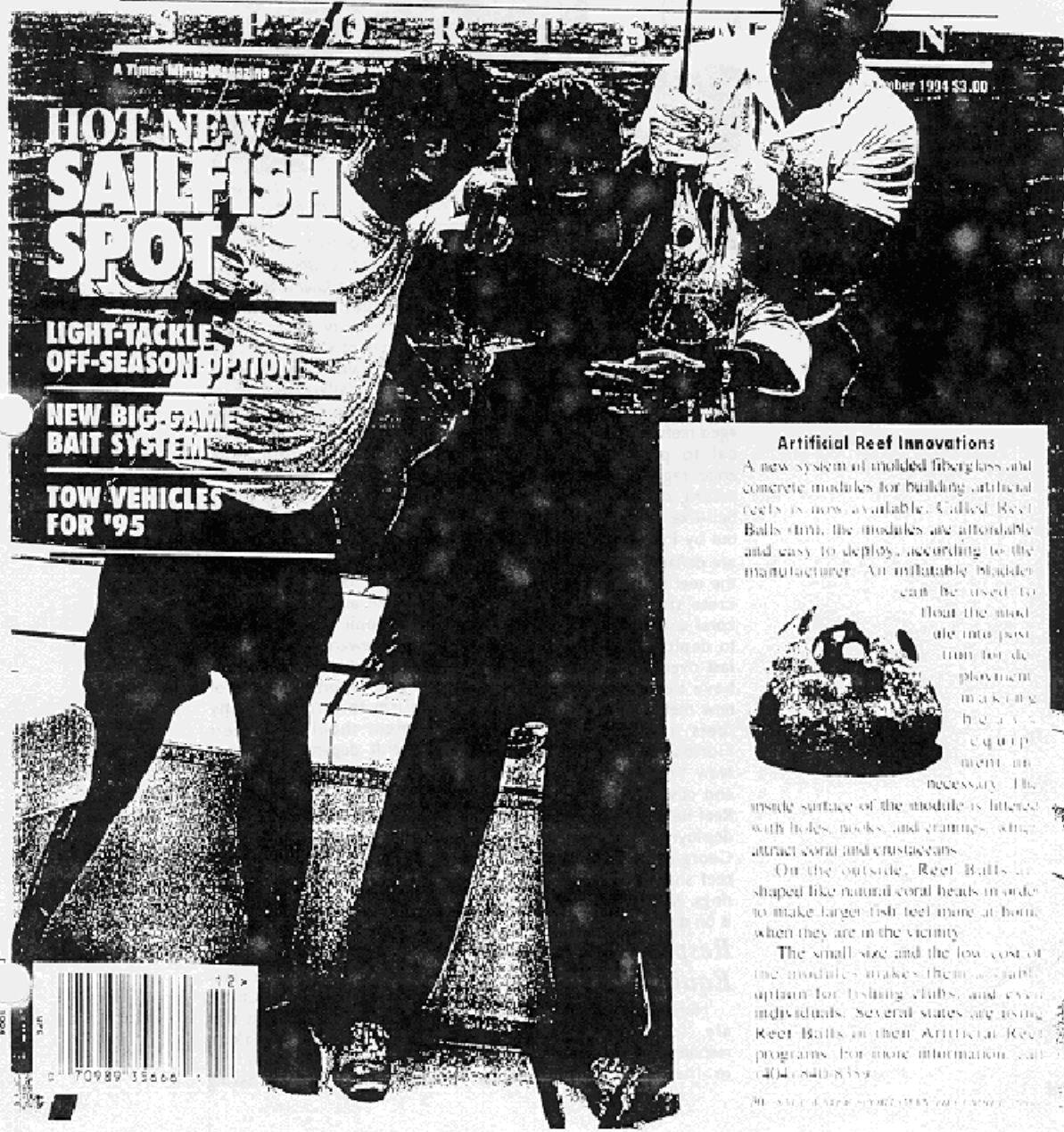

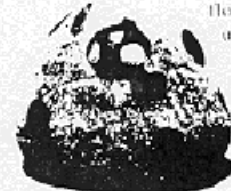

Artificial Reef Innovations

A new system of molded fiberglass and concrete modules for building artificial reefs is now available. Called Reef Balls™ first, the modules are affordable and easy to deploy, according to the manufacturer. An inflatable bladder can be used to



float the module into position for deployment, making the equipment necessary. The inside surface of the module is littered with holes, nooks, and crannies, which attract coral and crustaceans.

On the outside, Reef Balls are shaped like natural coral heads in order to make larger fish feel more at home when they are in the vicinity.

The small size and the low cost of the modules makes them an ideal option for fishing clubs and even individuals. Several states are using Reef Balls in their Artificial Reef programs. For more information, call (404) 840-8359.
